Being Intentional.... (24/7)

- Makes you a different person at home and in your marriage.
- Can make you more purposeful at school and work.
- Makes you a different student (teens).
- Makes you a different employee (adults).
- Can help you to be less busy:
 - Easier to say yes to what you care about.
 - Easier to say no to what is less important.

Jesus: Mt 9:36-10:1

- 9:36 Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness.
- 37 When he saw the crowds, he had **compassion** on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.
- 38 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."
- 10:1 Jesus called his **twelve** disciples to him and gave them **authority** to **drive** out impure spirits and to **heal** every disease and sickness.

• Praying with (presence) people and for people (on your own)


Reaching Out
